2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Leave All Blades Be-  
5 hind Act”.



1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITED ITEMS LIST.**

2       The Assistant Secretary of Homeland Security  
3 (Transportation Security Administration) shall not modify  
4 the list of items prohibited from being carried aboard a  
5 passenger aircraft operated by an air carrier or foreign  
6 air carrier in air transportation or intrastate air transpor-  
7 tation set forth in section 1540 of title 49, Code of Federal  
8 Regulations, so as to permit any item contained on the  
9 list as of December 1, 2005, to be carried aboard a pas-  
10 senger aircraft.
