
Chairman Markey,

I am writing in response to your letter of April 13, 2010 to Michael Silberstein, the former CEO of Infantino, LLC. Your letter described concerns you have with the use of triclosan in certain consumer products.

It is our understanding that the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the agency with authority to regulate antimicrobial agents in our products, has recently completed a comprehensive assessment of triclosan. We further understand the EPA concluded that there were no risks of concern to human health including risks to infants and children.

Infantino continuously reviews all of our products to ensure safety, quality, and compliance with applicable laws and regulations. The information available to us at this time does not lead us to the conclusion that a discontinuation of our use of this chemical is appropriate. However, we continually monitor information on emerging hazards and if we become aware of any information that indicates that there is actually a hazard, we will take swift and appropriate action.
